COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

ARTS4302: Advanced Printmaking

Students continue to develop their skills in traditional print media through projects incorporating more complex processes as well as experimentation with non-traditional printmaking methods, combinations of multiple processes, and use of emerging, digital technologies. Students also present research on significant historic and contemporary artists along with innovative skills they have found or discovered. Students develop self-directed projects as a means of cultivating their personal vision and professional practice.

ARTS5317: MFA Printmaking

Graduate students work towards their thesis projects as they experiment with processes and techniques to create mature, innovative, articulate bodies of work. Depending on their progression through the program, students may complete assigned projects as a means of broadening their skillset and introducing them to new ideas, or they may be fully self-directed as execute their final thesis exhibition. Stacked with advanced undergraduate students, the MFA candidates contribute to a communal classroom environment as rolemodels and mentors.

ARTS4302: Advanced Printmaking: Visual Culture of Hollywood (cross-listed with MEDA4390)

This special two-week maymester section of Advanced Printmaking is co-taught with a member of the Department of Media Studies and presented as "Visual Culture of Hollywood." Each year, the course focuses on a different decade of American Cinema, as students watched a selection of films from that time frame and discussed relevant people, motifs, and context to better understand the relationship of film and culture. The discussion is ultimately disseminated as a series of screenprinting projects which used specific parameters to

highlight facets of visual culture associated with films of the era and culminate in stand-alone artworks which also capture the broader implications of the innovations of that media.

ARTS3302: Intermediate Printmaking

This course introduces students to intaglio printmaking. They begin with drypoint, etching, and aquatint, as a means of understanding the medium and materials, then continue with more advanced, color techniques such as chine-collé, à la poupée, multiple plate color printing, and viscosity printing. Additionally, students are introduced to the history of intaglio, important historical figures, and renown contemporary artists.

ARTS2333: Printmaking I

In this course, students are introduced to both relief printmaking and screenprinting. They create single-color and multiple-color reduction woodcuts and learn a variety of screenprinting techniques from both hand-drawn and digitally rendered matrices. Students also learn the significance of different papers, inks, and tools, as well as conventions like registration, editioning, and presentation. Students are introduced to historical and contemporary artists working with these processes.

ARTS3301: Life Drawing

This drawing course focused entirely on the human figure. Students draw from a model in almost every class, working through more complex poses at different durations, and experimenting with different materials. Outside of class, student complete analyses of anatomy and conceptual figurative studies. Students develop their observational skills in both intuitive, gestural studies and complex, refined drawings.

ARTS2323: Drawing III

This course allows drawing students greater flexibility as they are challenged to develop thoughtful conceptual nuance to increasingly open project parameters. Students experience new drawing materials while working with unconventional sizes and surfaces. Some projects integrate emerging digital technologies by incorporating drawing tablets or manipulating the drawing surface. Students are exposed to contemporary drawing innovations through research and discussion.

ARTS1317: Drawing II

As an extension of Drawing I, students are introduced to new materials and expanded techniques as they broaden their understanding and facility for drawing. Different projects incorporate toned paper, various pen techniques, 2-point perspective, and color materials. Students develop compositional skills through prompts which allow for more flexibility and creative decision-making.

ARTS1316: Drawing I

Students learn the basics of observational drawing through the understanding of foreshortening, spatial depth and chiaroscuro, and techniques like sight-measuring and linear perspective. They use graphite and charcoal on a variety of paper surfaces, executing projects with both linear contour and full value. Students are introduced to fundamental vocabulary and articulate their ideas and observations through readings, discussions, and critique.

ARTS2316: Painting I

This course covers basic techniques in watercolor and acrylic painting. Students learn about vocabulary, materials, tools, techniques, and principles by producing a variety of subject matter. Critiques give students an opportunity to analyze and discuss decisions and process with each project and collaborate in problem-solving discourse.

ARTS3367: Digital Design Tools and Applications

This course introduces students to digital tools for a variety of design applications. Primarily centered on Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator, projects address logos, typography, layout, digital imaging, printing and fabrication technologies, and time-based media. Attention is given to best practices for different digital media and background on how certain formats were developed for their intended functions.

GRDS1301: Foundations of Graphic Design

This section of graphic design foundations is specifically designed for non-graphic design majors, being required for art majors and an elective for media production majors. The course covers a wide variety of topics including digital imaging, logo design, layouts, typography, brand identity, printing, and presentation primarily using Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, and InDesign. Over several projects, students work to develop their own brand identity based on their personal art practice or another interest. Students are also introduced to historical perspectives of graphic design through lectures and research presentations.

ARTS2311: Design III- Color Theory

Color theory covers the basics of color formulation and description, as well as color relationships and advanced color interaction via the work of Joseph Albers. Students learn color mixing with assignments using gouache and Color-Aid paper and develop observational skills by seeking out found materials. There is a major emphasis on accurately using specific vocabulary to describe color, as well as a basic understanding of the science of light, optics, and color representation through technology.

ARTS1311: Design I- 2D Foundations

This course covers the fundamental concepts of 2D design. Projects are highly structured to target specific concepts and incorporate a variety of materials and techniques including cut paper, micron pens, and acrylic paint. Students are introduced to crucial vocabulary through a long-term sketchbook project and begin to develop skills for any art practice, such as sketching ideas, strategies for refinement, and critique etiquette.

ARTS1301: Art and Society (lecture)

This core curriculum lecture course covers the fundamental concepts for describing art and design work. It includes an overview of art historical perspectives and draws connections between contemporary artworks and sociopolitical circumstances. Students are particularly challenged to cultivate their visual assessment skills and means of describing what they see in concrete terms.

NURS4254: Professional Nursing Issues I-IV

This sequence of courses incorporates visual arts into the Accelerated BSN program of the TAMUCC College of Nursing of Health Sciences. It is team-taught between faculty from the College of Nursing and the Department of Art. Nursing students complete weekly studio assignments designed to exercise skills such as observation, coordination, visual acuity and collaboration. Additionally, the students participate in lectures structured around specific examples of artists and artmaking which contextualize art within society and culture, emphasizing a greater understanding and empathy towards different people and circumstances.
